Re: Tesco Linwood Exhibition Feedback

As you may be aware, the Tesco public consultation exhibition for our revised proposals in Linwood took place on the 24th and 25th November. Over 400 people attended the exhibition and our new proposals have been warmly received by local residents.

Leaflets and feedback forms were made available at the exhibition and distributed locally and the response to date has been overwhelmingly positive, with over 97% of respondents supporting the new plans – which will revitalise the area and create hundreds of local job opportunities.

The positive response to our revised proposals have been encouraging, with 98% of respondents agreeing that they will benefit from the improvements to Linwood town centre. People are also eager to access more value and choice locally, with 99% supporting our plans for a supermarket.

Moving forward we anticipate that demolition work will commence on site in the New Year, and I believe that by starting work on site this will help to reassure the community that we remain dedicated to the regeneration of Linwood town centre.

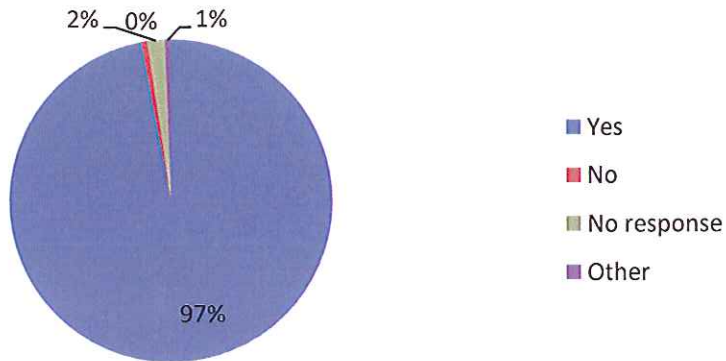

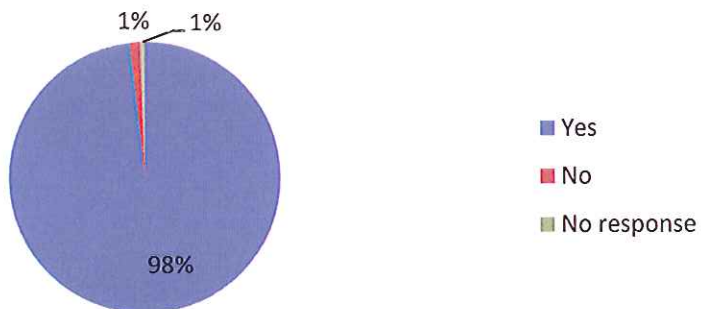
